Effective **Tuesday, September 3, 2024** MWRTA will revise schedules for

Routes 1, 2, 3, 6, and 14. *Here is what you need to know:*

Route 1: Timing adjustments throughout the entire schedule.

Routes 2 and 3 will have new stops, travel patterns, and timing adjustments throughout the entire schedule.

Route 2:

- When on Water St, the route will now stop in front of the Green Leaf Restaurant. From there, the route will turn left on Nicholas Rd, right on Pinewood, right on Elm, and make a second stop on Elm St. right after the turn.
- The MetroWest Medical Center will now be serviced at the end of the run, when heading to the Banana Lot. After leaving Rose Kennedy Lane and turning onto Concord St, the Route 2 will take a right into Lincoln St and stay straight to service the hospital. From there, it will turn right on Union St, left on Linden St, and left on Franklin St to go to the Banana Lot.
- Normandy Rd. / Flagg Dr. will be re-added as a stop point before servicing Rose Kennedy Lane.
- ***The Route 2 PM will now have a second bus added, providing 30–40-minute frequency between 1:30 PM – 7:30 PM.***

Route 3:

- When travelling on Concord St, the route will continue straight through the lights onto Elm St. The route will make a stop on Elm St and then turn left onto Pinewood and left onto Nicholas Rd, making a second stop at the end of Nicholas Rd before turning right onto Water St.
- The MetroWest Medical Center will now be serviced at the start of the run after departing the Banana Lot. After Framingham Center, the Route 3 will stay on Union Ave, turn right into Proctor St, and then services the Banana Lot.
- Normandy Rd. / Flagg Dr. will be re-added as a stop point before servicing Rose Kennedy Lane.

Route 6:

- Timing adjustments throughout the entire schedule.
- The Route 6 will have weekend service while travelling in to Milford in the morning, and back from Milford in the evening. Weekend timepoints will be listed on the **Route 14 Weekend Schedule**.

Route 14:

- Timing adjustments throughout the entire schedule.
- ***Will now have weekend service!*** The route will operate as the Route 6 in the morning travelling outbound to Milford, and in the evening when travelling inbound back to the hub. The weekend Route 14 will operate on Saturday's and Sunday's and will have the same stop points as the weekday schedule.
